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## HEALTH INFORMATION AND TECHNOLOGY WEEK – NOVEMBER 7 – 13, 2010

### *Did you know?*

- *Health Records staff:* retrieve approximately 73,000 charts per year *and* file approximately 1,500,000 sheets of paper onto charts per year
- *Health Information Management Professionals* handle approximately 11,800 release of information requests per year in accordance with the Health Information Protection Act, which in turn generates approximately \$120,000 worth of revenue
- In 2009 Royal University Hospital had 23,689 inpatient discharges, 9,601 daysurgery cases and 54,159 emergency room visits.
- For every inpatient discharge, daysurgery case and emergency room visit *health records staff* is required to assemble those visits in accordance with the Saskatoon Health Region's predetermined assembly order, they are required to perform qualitative assessment to ensure all pertinent documents are on the chart as well as facilitate physician dictation of incomplete records.
- *Health Information Management Professionals* are required to extract diagnostic and procedural information for all inpatient and daysurgery visits which are in turn abstracted and sent to a national data base. This data is then used both internally (senior leadership, clinicians, utilization, research) and externally (Ministries of Health, Stats Canada).

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
